As a teenager, Ms Kambo grew up listening to reggae music as her father's ears were constantly glued to the sounds of Bob Marley, Gregory Isaacs, Peter Tosh and other reggae music icons. Her youthful days were also influenced by a strong affinity to dance, a penchant she still holds to this day. Little did she know at the time that these formative experiences were training ground for her eventual entry into the entertainment industry as an adult.

Having lived through Liberia's various wars and social unrest, Ms Kambo ended up living in several refugee camps in Guinea during which time music became her saving grace and source of spiritual upliftment. Today, Ms Kambo, through her work in the community, has quickly become an entertainment giant in Ontario's Liberian community, functioning in part as a thought leader.

In 2018, Ms Kambo started Dream Makers Entertainment Inc. with a friend as a way of merging all of her interests. Since inception, Dream Makers Entertainment Inc. led by Ms Kambo, has gone on to organize many events, produced various music tracks, wrote, produced and Executive produced at least two music videos in less than a year. Ms Kambo's entrepreneurial drive has resulted in her working with Sampy Productions to produce entertainment events. It is no accident that Ms Kambo is now in the process of planning an international tour of artists in Liberia and Canada, and will be releasing a seven-song EP on November 9th, 2019 in Canada. Smitten by the drive to make a difference in the entertainment industry, Ms Kambo is also in the midst of developing a proprietary platform to harness and expose cultural products of Africans and their descendants. As Dream Makers Entertainment Inc. enters into a new chapter of its existence, Ms Kambo is excited at the prospect of facilitating the collaboration of artists from the afrobeat and reggae genres, opening up frontiers along the way.
