

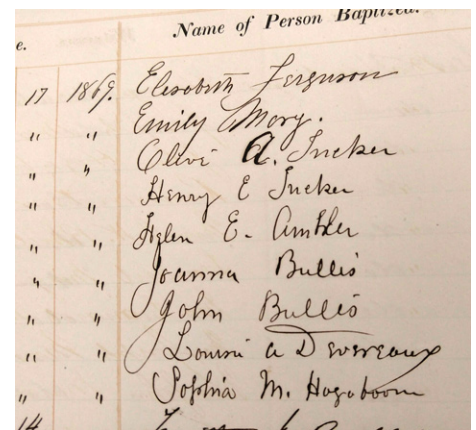
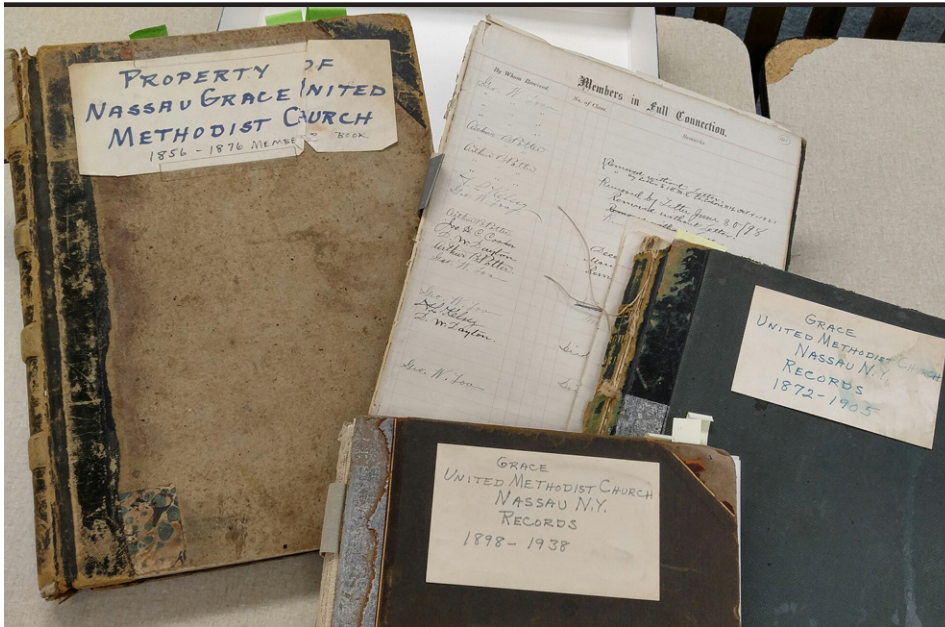

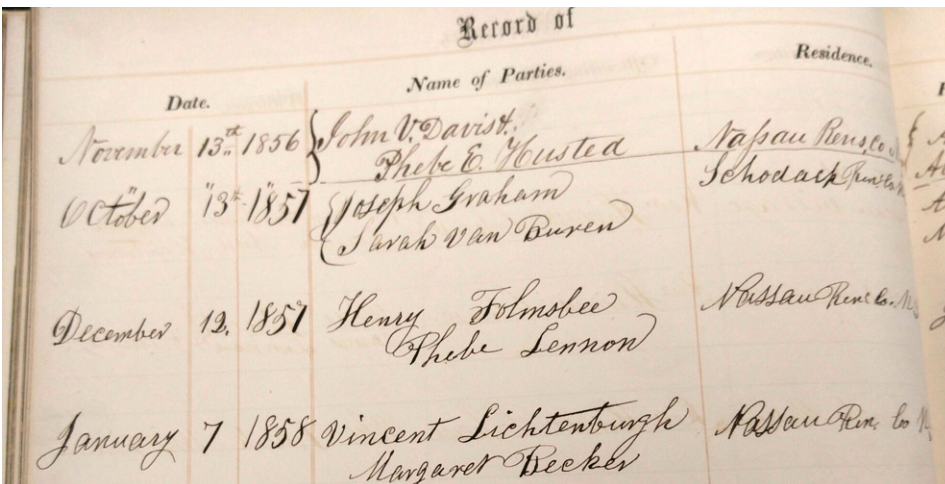
# All About Nassau

First organized in 1812, birth, baptism and marriage records exist from 1856.
