



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ-

Have you heard the story about the car that drove across country with only 3 tires? While I'm sure that would be an interesting story to hear, I haven't heard it. What I have heard is the story of families who have had to choose between driving safe vehicles or putting food on their tables or keeping a roof over their head. For over 25 years Morris and surrounding counties have seen my repair business, Rich's Automotive, as a center for honest car repair. During that time in business I've met many families like this who have deeply impacted the way I conduct business and the way Christ has led me to serve. Initially it started with discounted repairs or working with assistance from church benevolent funds, but I still felt deep in my heart that God was asking for more of me. That led to the birth of Kingdom Cars (KC) in 2015. Kingdom Cars is a 100% unique 501c3 non-profit full service garage focused on rebuilding the lives of low-income families through biblical budgeting classes and vehicle transportation needs.

Kingdom Cars is unique because it offers a resource to the church body that will overlap the financial gap as well as transportation needs for qualified applicants. After researching other church programs there was a clear pattern of repeat families with multiple needs. Our passion is to fully break the cycle of dependency and the financial spiral that brought them here in the first place. Our goal is to enrich the entire life of these families that agree to complete and apply a biblical based financial training program such as, "Crown Financial" or "Financial Peace University", and then either receive a donated car or free/ reduced income based car maintenance while growing in their walk with the Lord.

Our vision was anchored on 1 John 3:18 where we are called to take action as servants of the Lord. Would your church be willing to be an "anchor point" for the families in this program, both members and non-members (if needed) of your congregation? One of the most challenging parts of our program is to find churches that are willing to take on that calling. We need assistance to identify, and encourage the families that need our help the most. We are mechanics, not pastors. We are happy to help resolve transportation needs of these families, but that's just done one Saturday a month. The real resolution is Jesus! We need local churches, like yours, to help teach and guide these families about Christ's love, salvation, and to demonstrate God's unending mercy.
