

Mentor/ Accountability Guidelines

As always we appreciate and respect the relationship built between kingdom cars and your church. Any volunteers from your church are expected to abide by the following guidelines.

While you do not need an accounting background to assist in financial guidance/ mentoring you should have completed a biblically based financial counseling class. If you haven't and still wish to be a mentor we can supply you with information to do so.

The mentee cannot be a relative of you.

Keep in mind that time spent with your mentee should be quality time free of distractions.

Invite your mentee to discuss what they've learned in their financial training classes and challenge them to how they can apply that to their daily life.

Use discretion. In a good mentor relationship, you need to be assured your relationship is confidential. If he or she can't be trusted to keep confidences, your relationship will be superficial at best- damaging at worst. Honesty is crucial to a successful mentor/ mentee relationship.

Offer only constructive criticism and please don't be judgmental. Talk about, and encourage even their smallest accomplishments.

No one likes to learn from a know it all. Mentor with humility. It is Christ who is teaching and molding the lives of His people. You are simply a tool in His hand.
