**UAW REGION 1A

OVERVIEW**

THE GOALS

The Retired Workers Council has undertaken this program because neither the Michigan legislature nor Congress has provided the kind of educational opportunities young adults need in our complex world. We continue to struggle to remove the economic barriers to full educational opportunities while at the same time trying to help a few families provide their children with an education beyond high school.

ELIGIBILITY

To be a contestant, the student must be the child, grandchild, or ward of a member in good standing, working or retired, of a Local in UAW Region 1A. They must be graduating from high school in the contest year and must have been tentatively accepted by an accredited college, community college, or career-training institute. **Each applicant must submit an original essay of 500 words or less on the subject designated for that contest.**

There must be NO mention of a family member or UAW Local in the essay. Please make sure that all essays are double-spaced and have correct spelling and grammar.

ESSAY:

"Stand Up Strike"

How did the most recent stand up strike affect you and your family? (500 words or less)

AWARDS

Two (2) awards of \$1200, Four (4) awards of \$1000 and One (1) award of \$500 will be presented. Awards will be presented to the authors of the essays.

THE JUDGES

A panel of UAW Retirees will read each essay without knowing the author's identity. The content, clarity, and reasoning of the essay will determine the decision of these judges.

THE AWARDS

These awards are made possible by generous donations from UAW Locals and the Retired Workers Chapters of UAW Region 1A, the Director, and caring individuals. The awards are presented in memory of an individual who made significant contributions to the UAW and our community.
