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SECTION A

INVITATION FOR BIDS- (IFB) – IFB # 2023-04

The Groveland Municipal Light Department (or "MLP") invites bids from qualified bidders for Unit H metal siding replacement and modification as described in IFB-2023-04.

The scope of work statement is attached to this IFB. All questions or requests for clarification regarding this IFB should be made in writing to the attention of Kevin Snow with the IFB # in the subject line.

A payment bond in an amount equal to 50 percent of the total amount of the bid with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for the payment under the contract for labor and materials.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 44A-H and M.G.L c. 30, § 39M.

Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Department of Labor Standards under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 26-27D.

All proposals must be sealed and marked on the outside "Groveland Municipal Light Department Unit H removal and replacement of garage doors and accessories IFB # 2023-04" and be received at the office of the Groveland Municipal Light Department, 944 Salem Street, Groveland, MA 01969, no later than 9:00 a.m. on 6/13/2023, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

MLP reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities and minor irregularities in bids received, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the MLP to do so.

SECTION B

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Receipt and Opening of Bids

Groveland Municipal Light Department, also referred to as the Owner, will receive sealed Bids. Such bids shall be sealed in an envelope and marked and shall be addressed to Kevin Snow, General Manager, 944 Salem Street, Suite A, Groveland MA 01969. Such bids will be received at the MLP until 9 a.m., on 6/13/2023 at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified will not be considered. The bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 90 days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of bids.

2. Location and Work to be Done

The "Work" consists of the removal of the existing garage doors and replacement with new, oversized units with door tracks and garage door openers at 944 Salem Street, Groveland, MA 01969. (Please see Section D for Specifications).

Work must begin within (30) thirty calendar days after award of project.

The details of the Work are indicated in Section D, SCOPE OF WORK STATEMENT.

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, services, materials, tools, supplies, and all other things necessary to do all work required for the completion of each item of the Work and as herein specified.

The Work to be done and paid for under any item shall not be limited to the exact extent mentioned or described but shall include all incidental work necessary or customarily done for the completion of that item.

3. Preparation of Bid

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form, **Section C**, **BID RESPONSE**. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and endorsed with the name of the project as specified in <u>Receipt and Opening of</u> Bids, above.

4. <u>Bid Opening Procedure</u>

Bids shall be filed at the place and before the time specified in Section 1.

5. Ability and Experience of Bidder

No award will be made to any bidder who cannot satisfy the Owner that he has sufficient ability and experience in this class of work and sufficient capital and plant to enable him to prosecute and complete the work successfully. The Owner's decision or judgment on these matters will be final, conclusive, and binding.

The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary, and the bidder shall furnish to the Owner, all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. In addition to the information requested in **Section C**, **BID RESPONSE**, the following information must be submitted for inclusion in the bid evaluation process:

- A. The Contractor(s) shall submit a project description of work of a similar size and nature for a public entity (including entity's name, contact person, project location and dates of performance).
- B. The Contractor shall submit proof of necessary trade licenses as required by Massachusetts law.
- C. The Contractor must have previous experience working [on similar projects] and provide references of completed jobs.

6. Conditions of Work

Each bidder must familiarize himself fully with the conditions relating to the construction of the project and the employment of labor thereon. Failure to do so will not relieve a successful bidder of his obligation to furnish all material and labor necessary to carry out the provisions of his contract. Insofar as possible the Contractor, in carrying out his work, must employ such methods or means as will not cause any interruption of or interference with the work of any other Contractor or Owner.

7. Security for Payment

Simultaneously with delivery of the executed Contract, the Contractor shall furnish a surety bond or bonds as security for the payment of all persons performing labor and supplying materials under this contract for 50% of the contract price, as specified in **Section G, PAYMENT BOND**, included herein.[only if project over \$25K]

The surety on such bond or bonds shall be a surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth and satisfactory to the Owner. The bonds shall remain in force for

one year after final acceptance of the work by the Owner, unless the Owner, in writing, releases the Contractor from the obligation sooner.

8. <u>Power of Attorney</u>

Attorneys-in-fact who sign Contract bonds must file with each bond a certified and effectively dated copy of their power of attorney.

9. Laws and Regulations

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State and Federal laws, municipal ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the Work ("Laws") shall apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the Contract the same as though herein written out in full.

10. Obligation of Bidder

At the time of the opening of bids each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents. The failure or omission of any bidder to examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect of his bid.

11. Information Not Guaranteed

All information given in the Contract Documents relating to subsurface and other conditions, natural phenomena, existing pipes and other structures is from the best sources presently available to the Owner. All such information is furnished only for the information and convenience of bidders and is not guaranteed.

No bidder or Contractor shall use or be entitled to use any of the information made available to him or obtained in any examination made by him in any manner as a basis of or ground for any claim or demand against the Owner, arising from or by reason of any variance which may exist between the information made available and the actual subsurface or other structures actually encountered during the construction work, except as may otherwise be expressly provided for in the Contract Documents.

12. Rejection/Disqualification

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or reject any and all bids, should the Owner deem it to be in the public interest to do so.

The Owner may also reject bids which in its sole judgment are incomplete, conditional, obscure or not responsive or which contain additions not called for, erasures not properly initialed, alterations, or similar irregularities.

The Owner also reserves the right to reject the bid of any bidder that the Owner considers to be unqualified based on the criteria set forth in Article 5 herein.

The following, without limitation, are some of the causes, which may be considered as sufficient for the disqualification of a bidder and the rejection of his bid:

- A. More than one bid for the same work from an individual, firm, partnership or corporation.
- B. Evidence of collusion among Bidders.
- C. Poor performance in the execution of work under previous contract.
- D. Failure to achieve reasonable progress on existing contract.
- E. Default on previous contracts or failure to execute Contract Documents after award.
- F. Failure to fully complete Bid Form.

14. Award of Contract

The Contract will be awarded to "the lowest responsible and eligible bidder" pursuant to the procedures of the Massachusetts General Laws. Such a bidder shall possess the skill, ability and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work, shall be able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed, or to be employed, in the work, and shall otherwise comply with all applicable provisions of law.

15. Statutes Regulating Competitive Bidding

Any bid which does not comply with the applicable provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, §§44A *et seq*. and M.G. L. c. 30, §39M need not be accepted and the Owner may reject every such bid.

16. Wage Rates

Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Division of Occupational Safety, Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 26 – 27G, apply to this project. Prevailing wage rates for this project are included in **Section J**, **PREVAILING WAGE SCHEDULE**.

17. Contractor Records

The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30, § 39R, concerning Contractor records.

18. Insurance

The Contractor shall carry and continuously maintain until completion of the Contract, insurance as specified in **Section H, CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE.**

19. <u>Terms and Conditions</u>

The successful bidder will be expected to sign the **OWNER AGREEMENT** in **Section E**, attached to which will be Terms and Conditions to the Agreement, appearing in substantially similar form as set forth in **Section I**, **OWNER'S TERMS AND CONDITIONS** and **Section K**, **OWNER'S SUPPLEMENTARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

20. OSHA Certification

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30, § 39S, the Contractor must be able to certify that all employees to be employed at the worksite will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration at the time the employee begins work and must furnish documentation of successful completion of said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee.

- 3. Remove existing garage door tracks; save for re-installation with new doors
- 4. Remove existing garage door opener and controls; save for re-installation with new doors.

- 6. Furnish and install new garage door tracks and associated bracing/hardware in renovated garage door opening.

SECTION E

OWNER AGREEMENT

This agreement for materials, equipment and/or contractor services as described herein ("Agreement") is hereby entered into by and between the MLP, a Massachusetts municipal light department with offices at [address] ("Owner" or "MLP") and CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR ADDRESS ("Contractor") (collectively, the "Parties").

WHEREAS, on or about May 24th 2023, pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, § 44A and c. 30, § 39M Owner invited bids for the Garage Door removal and replacement pursuant to Owner's IFB No.2023-04 (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, on [DATE ON BID] Contractor submitted its Bid in response to Owner's IFB No. (Exhibit B), and

WHEREAS, Owner desires to purchase, and Contractor desire to provide [describe project briefly] subject to the scope, terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the mutual covenants set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Owner and Contractor agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Contract Documents</u>: The following documents are incorporated into this Agreement as fully as if stated within the body of this Agreement and shall be appended as Exhibits A through F hereto:
 - Owner's IFB No. 2023-04, including the "Scope of Work Statement" (Exhibit A);
 - Contractor's Bid Response dated (Exhibit B);
 - Purchase Order (Exhibit C);
 - Payment Bond (Exhibit D)
 - Owner's Terms and Conditions (Exhibit E);
 - Owner's Supplemental Terms and Conditions (Exhibit F)
 - Certificate of Vote (if Applicable) (found at the end of this Agreement)

In the event of a conflict between this Agreement and any Exhibits attached hereto, the Owner's Terms and Conditions shall take precedence. In the event of a conflict between the Owner's Terms and Conditions and the Massachusetts General Laws, the Massachusetts General Laws shall prevail. All provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws regarding public construction, wages and bidding that are applicable to this Project are hereby incorporated by reference into this Agreement.

2. <u>Payment</u>: The Parties have agreed to the following payment terms.

Owner shall make payment to Contractor the net dollar amounts shown on Purchase Order _____for materials, equipment and/or services delivered, invoiced, and accepted by the Owner, with payment due thirty (30) days thereafter.

- 3. <u>Purchase Order</u>: Owner has issued a Purchase Order ____ in the amount of \$____ for Items as set forth in the Bid Response (Exhibit B) to be paid in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. Upon receipt of the Purchase Order, which is issued pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, Contractor shall consider such receipt as its "notice to proceed" and shall commence performance under the Agreement.
- 4. <u>Waiver/Amendment</u>. Any term of this Agreement may be amended and the observance of any term of this Agreement may be waived (either generally or in a particular instance and either retroactively or prospectively), only by a writing signed by an authorized representative of each Party and declared to be an amendment hereto. No waiver by either Party of any default(s) by the other Party in the performance of any provision, condition or requirement herein shall be deemed to be a waiver of, or in any manner release such other Party from, performance of any other provision, condition or requirement herein, nor deemed to be a waiver of, or in any manner release the defaulting Party from, future performance of the same provision, condition or requirement.
- 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement is declared invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall in no way affect the validity or effectiveness of the other provisions of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect, and the Parties shall thereafter use their best efforts to modify or reform this Agreement so as to effect the original intent of the Parties as closely as possible with respect to the provision that were held to be invalid or unenforceable.
- 6. <u>Counterparts</u>. This agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if both parties had signed the document. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one and the same agreement.
- 7. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed, interpreted and performed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without giving effect to its conflict of law principles. Any action or proceeding concerning this Agreement shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By execution of this Agreement, each of the Parties hereto accepts for itself and its property, generally and unconditionally, the jurisdiction of the aforesaid courts. Each of the Parties hereto irrevocably consents to the service of process of any of the aforementioned courts in any such action or proceeding by the mailing of copies thereof by certified mail, postage prepaid, to the Party pursuant to the notice provisions hereof. Should any action be brought pursuant to this Agreement, the Parties waive their right to a jury trial.
- 8. <u>Notice</u>. Any notice required or permitted under this Agreement or required by law must be in writing and must be delivered in person, by certified mail (return receipt requested), or by a nationally recognized overnight service with all freight charges prepaid, to the address set forth below. Notices will be deemed to have been given at the time of actual delivery, if in person, or upon receipt (as evidenced by facsimile confirmation, return receipt or overnight delivery verification). Either Party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other Party in accordance with this Section.

SECTION I

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AGREEMENT

The following terms and conditions will be incorporated by reference in to the Agreement that shall constitute the entire understanding between MLP and the Contractor, and no modifications, rescission, waiver or termination of the Agreement or any of its terms and conditions, shall be binding on MLP unless agreed to in writing by MLP. Capitalized words not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Agreement.

PERFORMANCE

If the Contractor shall fail in any respect to perform his obligations under the Agreement with promptness and diligence, MLP may cancel the Agreement in part or in its entirety without liability whatsoever for any portion(s) so canceled.

WARRANTY

The Contractor warrants to MLP that the materials and/or equipment and construction services ("or work") provided under the Agreement shall be free from all encumbrances and shall be in accordance with MLP requirements, shall be new and free from defects in material, workmanship and shall meet all specifications and instructions of MLP.

If the article(s) purchased or services provided does not meet the warranties above, MLP, after determining a defect or nonconformance, will notify the Contractor. At the sole discretion of MLP, the Contractor shall replace, repair or restore, and/or reperform without cost to MLP, any defects or nonconformance arising within one year after date of acceptance of the article(s) furnished and/or the work performed.

Any replacement, repair, or reperformed work furnished by the Contractor under aforesaid warranty shall carry warranties on the same terms and conditions of said replacement, repair or reperformed work.

TERMINATION FOR CAUSE/FORCE MAJEURE

MLP reserves the right to terminate this Agreement for its convenience. In such event Contractor shall immediately stop all services work and observe any instructions from MLP as to work in process. Time is of the essence. In the event of Contractor's default by reason of failure to deliver material,

equipment and/or work in connection therewith as and when specified, or to prosecute the work covered hereunder with promptness and diligence, MLP may cancel this Agreement in its entirety, or any part thereof, by written notice to Contractor, all for cause, without prejudice to MLP's other rights and all without liability to itself. In such event, MLP may assume the work under the Agreement and replace it and/or prosecute the same to completion by contract or otherwise. In such cases, Contractor shall be liable to MLP for any additional costs incurred by MLP thereby. These rights and remedies are in addition to any rights and remedies provided by law or under this Agreement. MLP shall not be liable to Contractor for any amounts, and Contractor shall be liable for, and shall hold MLP harmless from, any damages occasioned by the Contractor's breach or default. Contractor shall not be entitled to any claim for loss of anticipated revenue, including overhead and profit, due to cancellation or termination of this Agreement for cause. If it should be determined that the MLP has improperly terminated this contact for default, such termination shall be deemed to be for the MLP's convenience. If MLP terminates this Agreement for convenience, all payments due to the Contractor under the Agreement up to the date of termination, in accordance with all Agreement terms, shall be paid by MLP to Contractor. In the event of an Agreement for the provision of services, the payments to Contractor shall not exceed the fair value of Contractor's work, as MLP may determine.

Except as set forth in this Agreement, neither Party shall hold the other responsible or liable for damages or delays in performance caused by acts of God, or other events beyond the control of the other Party, that could not have been foreseen or reasonably prevented. Such acts or events shall include unusually severe weather affecting performance, floods, epidemics, war, riots, strikes and lockouts. Delays within the scope of this provision which cumulatively exceed sixty (60) days in any six (6) month period shall, at the option of either Party, make this Agreement subject to termination, with no further liability to either.

PATENTS, TRADEMARKS, COPYRIGHTS

It is mutually agreed and understood that the Agreement includes all royalties and costs arising from patents, trademarks and copyrights in any way involved with the work. If the Contractor, or any of its subcontractors, are required or desires to use any design, device, material or process covered

by letters, patents, trademark or copyright, the Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless MLP from any and all claims for infringement by reason of use of any such patented design, device, material or process to be performed under the Agreement and shall further indemnify MLP for any actions, claims, expenses and damage which MLP incurs or may be obligated to pay by reason of such infringement at any time during the performance or after the completion of the work. MLP will give to the Contractor notification of any such action, claim, or proceeding and shall furnish the Contractor (at the Contractor's expense) all reasonably necessary information and assistance to enable the Contractor to defend the same.

If any material, equipment or work in any action, claim or proceeding is held to constitute infringement or its use is enjoined, the Contractor, within a reasonable time, shall either secure for MLP, at the Contractor's own expense, the right to continue using said material, equipment or work by suspension of the injunction, by procuring for MLP a license, or otherwise, or shall at the Contractor's own expense and as MLP may elect, replace such material, equipment or work or modify it so that it becomes non-infringing, or remove such infringing material, equipment or work and refund the sums paid theretofore by MLP, all without injury or damage to any other property of MLP.

INSPECTIONS/ ACCEPTANCE

All materials, equipment and/or services to be supplied under the Agreement are subject to inspections by MLP or its representatives. MLP's acceptance of, and/or payment for equipment, supplies and/or related services shall not constitute a waiver by it of any claims it may have or warranties under this Agreement.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAW/OSHA CERTIFICATION

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, regulations, ordinance, by-laws and orders that govern this Agreement ("Laws") whether or not specifically referenced. Contractor also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless MLP from any and all damages, claims and liabilities arising from Contractor's noncompliance with said Laws.

The Contractor shall give all notices required by law and comply with all Laws relating to the conduct of the performance of the contract.

If the Contractor observes that the drawings or specifications are at variance with any law, ordinance, rule or regulation, MLP shall be notified promptly in writing, and any necessary changes shall be made pursuant to MLP's instructions or change order. If the Contractor performs any work knowing it to be contrary to such Laws, Contractor shall bear all costs of required changes and be liable to MLP for all damages arising therefrom.

Contractor hereby certifies that all employees to be employed at the worksite will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration at the time the employee begins work and must furnish documentation, prior to commencing the work under the Agreement, of successful completion of said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee.

TAXES

MLP is an organization exempt from the payment of state and local taxes on tangible property and services and will not reimburse the Contractor for such taxes incurred by the Contractor in the performance of the Agreement.

RISK OF LOSS

Risk of loss and/or liability for damages for any of the materials or equipment specified in the Agreement shall remain with the Contractor until such items are delivered and accepted by MLP. All deliveries shall be F.O.B.[insert town] Massachusetts unless otherwise designated by MLP in the Agreement.

IDENTIFICATION

The Contractor shall properly identify each shipment, by Purchase Order or Contract Number, commodity description and packing list. All items, packages, etc. will have clearly identifiable external markings or tags for ease of identification.

ASSIGNMENT

Neither the Agreement nor any payment due or to become due hereunder shall be assignable by the Contractor without the prior written consent of MLP. Any such assignment(s) without MLP's prior written consent shall be void. Should MLP agree to an assignment, the Contractor shall remain fully responsible for the acts and omissions of the Contractor's assignee and the Contractor shall indemnify and hold MLP harmless from any and all loss and expense arising out of the assignment.

RECORDS/AUDIT

The Contractor shall, at its own expense, keep and maintain complete records and books of account of its costs and expenses relating to the work under the Agreement in accordance with generally accepted accounting practices. Contractor shall maintain such records for at least six (6) years after final payment, which in reasonable detail accurately and fairly reflect the dispositions of the Contractor under this Agreement. Until the expiration of six (6) years after final payment, MLP and any other public official authorized by law shall have the right to examine such records that directly pertain to and involve transactions relating to Contractor under the Agreement. Contractor hereby grants MLP or its authorized representative permission to audit such records and books of account at the Contractor's usual place of business at reasonable times.

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Any of MLP's drawings, specifications or technical information used by the Contractor hereunder, shall remain the property of MLP and shall be held in confidence by the Contractor and shall not be reproduced or disclosed to others without the written permission of MLP.

WAIVER

In the event MLP fails to insist on strict performance of any of the terms and conditions or fails to exercise any of its rights and privileges hereunder, such a failure shall not constitute a waiver of such terms, conditions, rights or privileges.

COMPLETION OF CONTRACT

The Agreement will not be considered complete until all specifications and requirements have been met and accepted by MLP. These requirements include, but are not limited to, MLP's acceptance of all documentation, drawings, manuals, plans and publications, as applicable.

PAYMENT TERMS

MLP Payment terms are net 30 days upon receipt of invoice after receipt and acceptance of all goods or services to be furnished under the Agreement. If MLP objects to all or part of any invoice, MLP shall notify the Contractor in writing within 2 weeks of the date of the invoice, and shall pay the portion of the invoice not in dispute as set forth above. The Parties shall immediately make every effort to settle the disputed portion of the invoice.

SECTION K

SUPPLEMENTARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO AGREEMENT

INSURANCE Without limiting any other obligation or liability of the Contractor, sub-Contractor or any of its subcontractors or anyone employed by them directly or indirectly, agrees to obtain and maintain during the term of the Agreement, at its own expense with companies acceptable to MLP, insurance coverage of the type and amount (limits) as follows below:

- <u>1.General Liability</u> for the Project of at least \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability, Combined Single Limit with a \$1,000,000 Annual Aggregate Limit. <u>Products and Completed Operations</u> shall be maintained for 2 years after the completion of the Work.
- 2. <u>Automobile Liability</u> for the Project (applicable for any contractor who has an automobile operating exposure) of at least \$500,000 per person/\$1,000,000 Occurance Bodily Injury and \$1,000,000 Property Damage per accident.
- 3. <u>Umbrella Liability</u> for the Project of at least \$500,000 / occurrence, \$1,000,000 aggregate.

Certificates of Insurance acceptable to MLP shall be filed with the MLP prior to commencement of any work on Owner's premises. These Certificates shall contain a provision that coverages afforded under the policies will not be cancelled until at least thirty days prior written notice has been given to MLP. Certificates of renewal shall be delivered to MLP at least fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration date of any insurance policy. The Contractor shall not commence any service until all insurance required hereunder shall have been obtained and approved by MLP, and the Contractor shall not permit any subcontractor to commence work until all insurance required of them shall have been similarly obtained and approved. Coverage shall remain effective for a period of two (2) years after termination of the Agreement for any reason.

In addition, the Contractor will comply with all federal and state workers compensation or similar laws that impose any charge or liability on MLP in connection with this Agreement. The Contractor will provide workers' compensation insurance with not less than the statutorily required limits covering all of its employees in accordance with such laws, and, in addition, Employer's Liability insurance and a waiver of subrogation in favor of MLP. The limit for Employer's Liability may be not less than \$1 million per accident and must be a separate policy if not included with Worker's Compensation coverage. Evidence of the insurance will be in the form of a certificate issued by Contractor's insurance carriers.

Contractor's liability coverage shall be endorsed naming MLP as an "Additional Insured" and certificate(s) for the same shall be indicated on their face by the words: "MLP is named as an Additional Insured." Such policies shall also be endorsed to contain waivers of insurer's subrogation rights against MLP by including the following language or similar language on the certificate: "The Contractor waives its right of subrogation against and in favor of MLP, as an Additional Insured, which may arise

by reason of payment of a claim under the policy." Contractor shall indemnify and hold MLP harmless for failure to effect such waiver(s). Certificates utilizing the ACORD form shall also clearly evidence in the blank "Description of Operations" or "other" block that "Contractual Liability Coverage is included in the General Liability coverage and has not been excluded," or words that mean or have similar effect.

The required coverage shall be primary to any other coverage available to Owner and shall not be deemed to limit Contractor's liability under this Agreement. Contractor shall be liable for all deductible amounts from such insurance and shall hold MLP harmless therefrom. Failure of Contractor or any of its subcontractors or assigns or any other party for which it is legally responsible, to maintain required coverage shall not relieve any of them of any responsibility, obligation or liability arising out of the Agreement.

Nothing contained in this provisions is to be construed as limiting the extent of the Contractor's obligations to indemnify and hold MLP harmless as set forth in this Agreement.

INDEMNIFICATION Contractor, its employees, agents, subcontractors and others for whose acts any of them may be legally responsible, shall indemnify and hold harmless MLP, its commissioners, managers, engineers, consultants, agents and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, causes of action, fines, penalties, court costs, damages, losses and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees), arising out of or resulting from, occasioned by or in connection with the performance or non-performance of its obligations under the Agreement, on account of any damages, loss or destruction of property or personal injury, including death, to any person, caused in whole or in part by any negligent, grossly negligent, or intentional act or omission of the Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, regardless of whether or not it is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder, and regardless of whether the loss, damage, destruction or injury resulting from same occurs after Contractor has left the property of MLP; or attributable to the release or disposal of or exposure to persons of Contractor's Hazardous Materials, as defined herein; provided however, that this indemnification obligation shall not apply to any claims to the extent arising from the gross negligence or intentionally wrongful acts or omissions of MLP.

For the purposes of this Agreement, "Contractor's Hazardous Materials" means any hazardous, toxic or polluting substance, material, chemical, waste or contaminant, or residues thereof, as defined or regulated pursuant to all applicable Laws as may be amended from time to time, that are brought on to MLP's property, furnished, applied, used, stored or released or otherwise introduced into or onto MLP's property by Contractor or any subcontractor or any person for whom Contractor is legally responsible.

Contractor's indemnification obligations shall survive termination of this Agreement for any reason.

PAYMENT BOND Simultaneously with delivery of the executed Agreement, the Contractor shall furnish a surety bond or bonds as security for the payment of all persons performing labor and supplying materials under this Agreement as specified in **Section G, PAYMENT BOND** of Owner's IFB #____ and in an amount as described therein (attached to this Agreement as "Exhibit D").

- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the iournevworker's rate.
- · Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS.
