

Basic Esthetics Program Description

In the 600 hour esthetics program, students will learn anatomy and physiology of the skin, skin disorders and pathology, chemistry and cell development, introductions to spa and medical facials, facial massage, waxing and make-up application. Students will receive a diploma in Esthetics from our school and will be eligible to take the Virginia State Licensure exams after graduation. Our course meets the guidelines set forth by the state of Virginia as well as many other surrounding states.

Curriculum areas we will focus on for lecture include:

Orientation and Business Topics; Laws and Regulations; General Sciences; Applied Sciences; Skin Care; Makeup; Body and Other Treatments; Hair Removal

Hands on practical performances required for course completion include:

Consultations, cleansings and analysis of face and body	35
Manual facials and treatments	65
Machine or electrical facials and treatments	50
Body treatments and back treatments	20
Makeup	25
Hair Removal	25

Students are required to purchase their own books and uniforms.

Uniforms will consist of black scrubs. They can be purchased at Walmart or any of the local uniform shops. You will be allowed to wear appropriate casual attire for the beginning classes and during lecture days.
