## Master Esthetics Program Description

Throughout our 600 hour Master Esthetician program we prepare our students for the medical side of esthetics. We train on more aggressive treatments such as microdermabrasion and chemical exfoliation with the use of AHAs, BHAs, and Jessner Solutions. Being a Master Esthetician opens doors for our students to work on the full body and advanced modalities. Students will receive a diploma in Master Esthetics from our school and will be eligible to take the Virginia State Licensure exams after graduation. Our course meets the guidelines set forth by the state of Virginia.

Curriculum areas we will focus on for lecture include:

Orientation, advanced business subjects, and infection control; State laws, rules and regulations; Advanced anatomy and physiology; Advanced skin care and advanced modalities (including microdermabrasion and dermaplaning); Advanced procedures and chemical exfoliation; Lymphatic drainage

Hands on practical performances required for course completion include:
