

## Impact Report - 2018



We issued seven of our "Say Yes" adoption grants last year to help families bring their children home.

Three of them were our Downright Lovable grants specifically dedicated to Down Syndrome adoption.

At least two of our grant families from 2017 were united with their children in 2018, too!

Currently, 19 supporters are financially sponsoring the 12 orphans designated to our monthly sponsorship program.

Six of these children are in Uganda, five of them in Cambodia, and one in China.





Over 100 people came together to fully fund an open heart surgery for Jane, an 18-year-old orphan who waited far too long for surgical intervention.

She has recovered well, thank God!

We raised over \$16,000 to protect orphaned children from child trafficking through stable, successful safe havens and program initiatives in Cambodia, Philippines, and Guyana in 2019.





We started Phase II of our Hearts of Hope project, shipping four more stateof-the-art pulse-oximetry units to medical foster homes in China.

This equipment will safely monitor approximately 60 orphaned children as needed in Shanghai Healing Home, Holt - Blue Sky Healing Home, Holt - Lily's House, and First Hugs.

We donated medical supplies and developmental toys to meet the basic needs of orphaned children in the loving care of Butterfly Hospice Home.

This was a joyous way we celebrated a friend/supporter's birthday that was donated to our ministry on Facebook.





We helped partially fund heart surgery for a precious orphaned baby boy named Finn at Morning Star Family Home in China last February.
