Thank you all so much for your support and interest, we are very excited about this new venture! Come see us! 😂





What is Benefits Counseling?

Employment

Benefits Counseling helps individuals understand how different situations like employment, changes in income, or life events can impact various benefits. Benefits Counselors will assist with exploring work incentives, creating plans to achieve employment goals, and improving financial outcomes.









Benefits Analysis and Advisement

Benefits Counselors will assist in creating an individualized plan to navigate employment while maintaining benefits such as SSI, SSDI, Medicaid, SNAP, and more. Benefits Counselors will also help you with understanding work incentives and reporting requirements.

Informed Decision Making

Benefits Counselors provide Information and Education related to how employment and other life situations affect your benefits. This gives participants the confidence and understanding to make informed decisions regarding their benefits and future.

Advocacy and Support

Benefits Counselors can help Problem Solve, Navigate complex systems, and even Advocate for the rights on individuals. Benefits Counselors can assist with appeals, resources, understanding requirements, and completing applications for benefits.

Blye Envelope Program

Boulder Police Department recently introduced a new program for drivers with intellectual or developmental disabilities and/or drivers on the autism spectrum called the "Blue Envelope Program." The program was created to give drivers the opportunity to share important information regarding their identity & their needs (via the blue envelope) with an officer as soon as they are pulled over or the interaction begins. 
