

OWL CLUB OF DENVER HISTORY

- On March 24, 1949, The Owl Club of Denver was chartered in the State of Colorado. The Club colors were established as Brown and White and an Owl as the emblem.
- In 1951, the group selected its first ten young ladies from Manual and East High Schools on the basis of scholastic performance and community service rather than socioeconomic status for a debutante ball.
- The Owl Club Debutante Ball was the first such presentation in the City and County of Denver. The first cotillion was held at the Park Hill Country Club.
- In 1952, Mrs. Ernestine Smith, wife of Owl Club member George W. Smith Jr., was asked to choreograph the dance – Waltz of the Bells which continues as part of the debutante cotillion tradition.
- On May 15, 1960, The Owls dedicated their new club house. There were 26 members.
- When the Air Force Academy moved from Lowry Air Force Base to Colorado Springs, the Academy's Director of Social Affairs called Owl Club member, Colonel Hubert 'Hooks' Jones, about the lack of social affairs for Black Cadets. As a result, the Club made the cadets 'Junior Owls' and made the club house available to them to entertain friends while in Denver. For several years thereafter, the cadets assisted the Debutantes during the Debutante Cotillions.
- In 1964 and 1965, the Club formed the Owl Club Youth Incentive, Athletic & Scholarship Association under the direction of Omar Blair to help youngsters in East Denver acquire football skills for high school. Mr. Blair and his committee were able to convince the NBA to play two pre-season games in Denver. The proceeds of the games financed a little league football team called the Owls.
- Owl member, Omar Blair was the first Black president of the Denver School Board. He held the position from 1972 to 1984.
- Owl member, William Kirk established the first Owl Club Scholarship Fund. In 1979, Owl member, Wilbur Hardy chaired the first 'Afternoon with the Owls' at the Country Dinner Playhouse, the proceeds from which went to increase the Owl Club Scholarship Fund.
- In 1999, the Blair-Caldwell African-American Library was envisioned and named after Omar Blair, and Elvin Caldwell, the first black City Council member.
- June 2010, the Lindsey-Flanigan Denver Justice Center was dedicated. James C. Flanigan, an Owl member, was the grandson of a slave. He worked his way through school and accomplished many African-American firsts including: first to graduate from college in his family, first to become a lawyer, first to join the Colorado Bar Association, was Denver's first Deputy District Attorney, the first Municipal Court Judge, and the first to be appointed to the Denver District Court bench.
- Dr. Bernard Gibson was an Owl Member for over 40 years and the first African American Board-Certified Surgeon in the State of Colorado. Dr. Gibson became Chief of Surgery in 1954 at Lowry Air Force Base and was a member of the faculty of the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center in the Department of Surgery, where he served for over 25 years and retired as a Clinical Associate Professor of Surgery.
- Owl member, Robert Shoates, was the first African American Postmaster between Chicago and the West Coast. He was later appointed to the position of Deputy Manager of Revenue for the Motor Vehicle Division, was one of the founders of the Greater Park Hill Sertoma, served as Chairman of the Owl Club Scholarship Fund, and was involved in various other community and business focused interests. In 2012 Bob received the Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award presented by the Colorado Civil Rights Commission.
