## TOURNAMENT RULES

1) The United States Bowling Congress (USBC) will certify this tournament. Bowlers will bowl on Sport compliant conditions and this event will be Scratch with an entry fee of $\$ 45$, Walk-in $\$ 55$
2) All Bowlers must hold a 2024-2025 USBC sanction card or will be required to purchase a $\$ 4$ youth standard sanction card.
3) Entry Fee must be paid in full by the date of the tournament is held. Please submit payment by cashier's check, personal checks, or money order, also credit/debit cards are accepted. Please make checks out to "Brett LaCruze Memorial Tournament". Credit Cards may be processed via a phone call to the bowling center also (734-449-4405).
4) Walk-in entries will be accepted only if lanes and roster spots are available.
5) Prize fund:
a. Scholarships will be paid with a minimum ratio of 1:4 based on participation with additional funds being provided by the Brett LaCruze Memorial fund at the Tournament Directors discretion.
b. All funds collected from "late fees/walk-ins" will be added to the prize fund.
c. Scholarship funds will be sent to USBC SMART via ACCT \#14500. Prize funds collected from entries will be returned 100\%.
6) Entry fee $\$ 45$. Broken down as follows: Bowling lineage: $\$ 15.00$, Expenses $\$ 5.00$, Scholarship fund $\$ 25.00$. Walk-in fee $\$ 55$.
7) Format/Lane Conditions:
a. Bowlers will start on freshly oiled sports conditions. The sport pattern will not be released until the day of competition, for fairness to all competitors.
b. All bowlers will bowl five (5) games. Bowlers will move after each game to a different assigned lane.
c. Tournament bowlers will get 10 minutes of practice on their starting pair. Practice will begin at 11am.
8) On site fundraising: The funds will be used at the tournament director's discretion to fund additional scholarships. Potential additional scholarships include but are not limited to:
a. Scholarship for 300 games bowled during the tournament.
9) Dress Code: Participants are required to adhere to the dress code:
A. Girls may wear: Jerseys and collared shirts with skirts/ skorts, or slacks of appropriate length.
B. Boys may wear: Jerseys and collared shirts and pants must be dress slacks or khaki pants.
C. Regardless of sex, no hats, no jeans, sweat clothes, spandex, leggings or t-shirts will be permitted.
10) Bowlers must check in at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the squad start time.
11) Each participant is responsible for recording his/her scores on the score sheet provided. Bowlers must sign their official score cards.
12) Only bowlers participating in this tournament and tournament staff will be allowed in the playing area during tournament play. Coaches, parents and spectators must stay in the spectator area.
13) Any actions determined to be inconsiderate of fellow participants and or bowling center property will NOT be tolerated. The tournament director will make the determination and may remove a bowler from the competition if needed. If this occurs, no entry fees will be refunded, or prizes awarded.
14) Divisions: There will be a Boys and Girls.
