

Soma Sense Academy Part-Time Training **Programme:** Soma Sense Service SETA- (3 years) **National Qualification in Hairdressing**

Students opting for a Part-time course will be completing National and International Qualifications simultaneously over a three-year period at Soma Sense Academy. The following conditions apply:

- Students are required to work full time in a Services SETA accredited salon.
- Supervised by a Hairdresser that has completed her Trade test (Red Seal Diploma).
- Students must attend Soma Sense Academy Hairdressing class on a Monday. This allows the student to complete the hours required.
- Should a student not work for a salon before they start with the course, they will have a limited period to secure one.
- It is the student's responsibility to provide their own models for all practical training and assessments.
- Classes will take place on Monday's from 08:00 15:00
