## 4-Week Workshop Series | Summary of Overall Review and Reflection 2025.7.31

The participants in this series of workshops included members of Twin Towers United Methodist Church (Alameda) and individuals from the local community, who learned about the events through the church's weekly newsletters, Facebook posts, and recommendations from friends. Notably, some participants came from Palo Alto. On average, individuals attended one to two times, and the exact number of participants is mentioned in the chart below. The majority of those who joined were middle-aged or elderly, though there were also children aged 7 to 12. Overall, the events proceeded smoothly. However, the atmosphere of each session varied depending on the specific theme of the day and the diverse life experiences each participant brought, collaboratively creating unique spiritual and creative environments. The conversations and interactions among participants sparked mutual inspiration and deepened individual expressions and reflections. Most participants had a strong passion for visual art creation but limited practical experience in drawing and painting, particularly with a variety of mixed media. The art materials provided in advance by the church played a significant role in supporting, enhancing the overall experience, and demonstrating a sense of care for the participants. From observation, the two main groups are obvious: one group of people is more focused on seeking instruction with specific artistic skills, engaging with the process in a relaxed and structured way; the other group expresses themselves through visual means in a more personal and therapeutic way, tapping into their untold stories and emotions. Also, a special thanks to my husband, Dr. Samuel Bai, for his kind assistance during the workshops and for leading live worship music at the beginning of each workshop, with additional support from my husband and our son, Bamboo. Their presence provided me with great warmth and extra strength.

My additional idea and thoughts: the study room for young kids next to the studio is an excellent space that complements and expands the teaching environment. In future workshops, this space can be further developed for multidisciplinary teaching. Some parents can engage in art creation, while their school-age children can also receive tutoring in various subjects or music lessons from my husband, Dr. Samuel Bai.

### \*ADDITIONAL NOTE: (UPDATED ON 2025.8.8) | A BRIEF CONCLUSION ON EVALUATION


The project in July was initially designed to unite the members of two churches during this transitional merger, as well as to serve as an outreach to the local communities for evangelism and sharing the good message. Its purpose is to promote unity and provide participants with a time of rest for their souls through art-making, allowing them to experience inner peace in God's presence. Art serves as a gentle and tender channel for connection. Therefore, the four workshops in July differ from regular art classes. Evaluations should reflect this unique context, not standard course criteria, as these workshops are not conventional "classes." God speaks personally to each participant.

Overall, it was a great start.


















