Tuna Fishery Day at the Aquarium

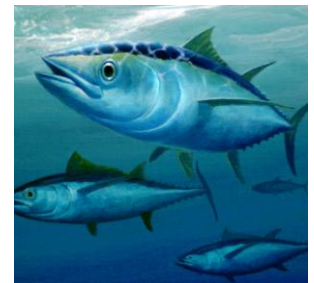

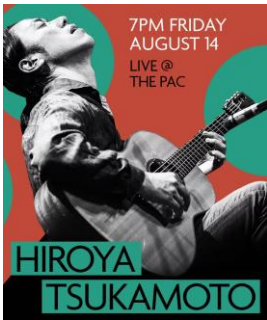
Newport's Music Entertainment

LIVE at the Performing Arts Center:



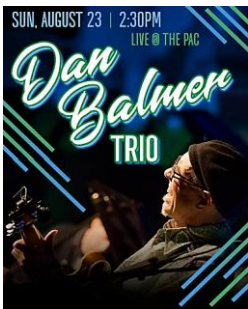
