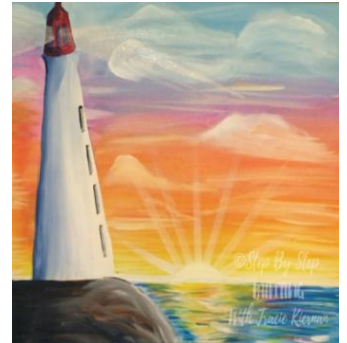

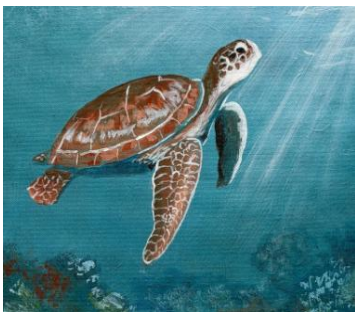

Finders Keepers **GLASS FLOATS ON THE BEACH**

Be on the lookout for the colorful twinkle of a hand-blown glass float. Going on year-round, handcrafted glass floats made by local artisans are hidden during the day, rain or shine, along seven miles of public beach from Roads End on the north to Siletz Bay on the south. If you find an official float, which has a number on the bottom, you are asked to register it at: explorelincolncity.com/register/ or by calling 541-996-1274. In addition to the regular floats, special floats are occasionally dropped.
