Ages 16+, adults over 21 can BYOB. Saturday, May 11th, 5:00 pm, Ticket fee is \$35.00.



Based on a true story, the opera is set in Nagasaki, Japan at the turn of the 20th century and tells the story of Lieutenant Benjamin Franklin Pinkerton, an American naval officer who marries Cio-Cio San, also known as Butterfly. This is just one of the fun facts you could learn about these feisty


echinoderms and other tidepool residents on our two upcoming Tidepool Excursions, but class space is limited.

On Thursday, May 9th at Otter Crest we will spend 2.5 hours exploring with the guide. There are several flights of stairs down to the beach and we will walk about 1 mile round trip on mostly rocks and some sand. If conditions are right, we will enter Devil's Punchbowl which will involve stepping up and onto boulders. Please be aware of your abilities.

On Friday, May 10th at Neptune State Park it's a short, gentle path to the beach, but there are some big steps and rocks at the end, and the 1.5 mile round trip will be on mostly wet firm sand.

Bloom NEWPORT 2024


