

Assignment Ideas for Moments Make the Man

This resource provides flexible assignment ideas for Canadian secondary classrooms. Tasks support English Language Arts, Social Studies, and Equity-focused instruction and may be adapted for Grades 9–12.

- Literary Analysis Essay: Examine how a defining moment shapes a character's development.
- Personal Narrative: Write about a moment that influenced your own values or perspective.
- Character Study Project: Track how a character evolves throughout the novel.
- Creative Monologue: Give voice to a character during a critical turning point.
- Comparative Essay: Connect themes from the novel to contemporary social issues.
- Visual Representation: Create artwork representing a pivotal moment in the story.
- Socratic Seminar: Discuss moral choices and their consequences.
- Found Poetry: Use key ideas or lines to construct an original poem.
- Media Connection Task: Analyze a film, article, or song with similar themes.
- Reflective Essay: Explain how the novel reshaped your understanding of identity or choice.
