Grassroots - First-time Referees

This course is for new, first time referees that have not been previously certified or registered. Grassroots referees can officiate competitive, small-sided or recreational youth and amateur adult matches.

Eligibility

In order to certify as a First Time Grassroots Referee, you must meet the follow eligibility standards:

- 13 years or older

Course Requirements

First Time Grassroots Referees must complete four (4) assignments in the Learning Center, attend an in-person field session and, if over the age of 18, complete an NCSI background check.

If you scroll down you will see all the new grassroots courses in Montana. To sign up for one the click the course details button. This will bring you to this page where you can register for the course.

If you are 18 years of age or older, it will require you to sign up for a background check first. This can take up to 10 days for the background check to process. If it takes more than that we have been told to contact the referee department at US Soccer. The system will not let you sign up for the course until the background check is cleared.

Before attending the in-person referee course there is an online course you must complete first. The online course is 4 hours 20 minutes to complete plus a quiz.
