Study Rooms

Purpose

The Acushnet Public Library provides study rooms for quiet study and tutoring to assist citizens in succeeding in formal education, independent learning and personal pursuits.

Policy

- 1. Study room users are required to have an Acushnet Public Library card or a card registered in the SAILS network. Study room users must be at least age 12 (or grades 6 and higher) or accompanied by an adult.
- 2. The study rooms are not sound proof. Study room users must be considerate of others. Audio devices that disturb others are not allowed. Avoid loud talking and excessive noise.
- 3. Covered beverages are allowed in the study rooms. Food is prohibited.
- 4. All study room users should be considerate of the next user and throw all trash in the receptacle provided.
- 5. Study rooms may be used for a total of two hours per day. The rooms are scheduled on the hour only and on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 6. If a study room user is more than 15 minutes late, s/he forfeits use of the room.
- 7. Users may extend their study room time for up to one hour and only if no one is waiting for the room. Please check with the staff before the end of your session.

Procedure

At least one study room user is required to sign in at the Information Desk before using the room. An ID must be left in exchange for a study room key.

Room A: No more than two users may occupy the room at one time.

Room B: No more than four users may occupy the room at one time.

Any failure to comply with the above policy and procedure may result in the loss of study room privileges.
