#### ASVAB - December 8th at 8:15AM

All juniors take the ASVAB as part of a state requirement. They will test in the computer lab on December 8th at 8:15AM.

#### **ACT or Accuplacer**

If you are a junior or senior and plan to take either the ACT or Accuplacer, the school district will pay the registration fee for the student (one time). For more information on this process contact Mrs. Meiners.

#### **Dual Credit**

Starting second semester, if a student earns an A or B in a Dual Credit course, we will reimburse the student up to \$300 per year (junior and senior years). There is still time to sign up for a dual credit course second semester. Students can pick up the dual credit enrollment form in the Counselor's Office.
