

CAMP FUSE PACKING SUPPLIES CHECK LIST and MISC INFORMATION

Things to bring

- ___ *change of clothes for each day plus at least two extra outfits
(8-10 outfits are recommended)
- ___ *closed toed shoes for playing games and running
(more than one pair of shoes are recommended)
- ___ *long pants for hiking
- ___ *flip flops or water shoes for showers
- ___ *towels, wash cloths/scrubby
(at least three towels are recommended. They get stinky)
- ___ *toothbrush and toothpaste
- ___ *DO for your BO (deodorant)
- ___ *Hairbrush, comb (girls- hair ties)
- ___ *bug repellent
- ___ *sunscreen
- ___ *bedding-sleeping bag and/or sheet and/or blanket and pillow
- ___ *bad for dirty laundry
- ___ *box fan (cabins get hot)
- ___ *power strip/extension cord
- ___ *flashlight
- ___ *BIBLE

**Extras-check the weather for the week of camp.

- ___ *Rain jacket/rain poncho
- ___ *sweatshirt/hoodie

Dress Code

- Shirt straps are to be at least 2 inches wide
- No low-cut shirts, no belly shirts etc Skin is to be covered
- Shorts no shorter than one-hand's width above the knee. No short shorts
- No questionable wording on clothing (vulgar etc)
- No advertising for adult oriented products (beer etc)
- No expensive jewelry (it could get lost)

DO NOT BRING

- +No extra food, drinks or candy (you WILL have unwanted "critters" in your cabin)
- +No electronic games/toys
- +No weapons (pockets knives, BB guns etc)
- +No fireworks
