### **2025 CONTRIBUTIONS**

If you wish to have your year-end contributions be counted in 2025, please note that <u>you must have the contribution to the church office by December 31<sup>st</sup> to count as a 2025 <u>contribution.</u> Note: The church office will be closed on <u>December 26<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>.</u> If you cannot make it to the church office, you can still make the contribution online on the church's website, <a href="https://LivingWordLutheranChurch.org">https://LivingWordLutheranChurch.org</a></u>

For those of you who are 70<sup>1/2</sup> or older, you may consider making a Qualified Charitable Deduction (QCD) from your IRA this year. By making the contribution from your Traditional IRA, you are allowed to deduct up to \$108,000 of the QCD from the front of your Form 1040 in arriving at your AGI. This could be even more beneficial if you are in a Required Minimum Distribution because this also counts toward your Required Minimum Distribution. Please consult with your own personal tax advisor to determine if you qualify for this type of contribution and to see how this could be a tax benefit to you.
