WHAT THE SECURITY PERSON DOES?

There is a security person located in the narthex near the front entrance during all worship services. They are responsible for monitoring the parking lot, placing the church sign out at the street entrance to the church before the service and bringing it back after the service, walking through the building checking doors, advising the nursery attendants of communion, and notifying the congregation of emergencies. There is a

airhorn on the usher's table in the narthex that the security person will use when there is an emergency affecting the congregation. One blast – shelter in place; Two blasts – exit the building.
