2022 Contributions

Reminder, if you wish to have your year end contributions to be counted in 2022, please note. The Church office is closed on December 30th and 31st, you must have the contribution to the church office by December 29th for it to count as a 2022 contribution. If you cannot make it to the church office by December 29th, you can still make the contribution online on the church's website https://livingwordlutheranchurch.org/give-1. For those of you, who are 70 ½ or older you may consider making a Qualified Charitable Deduction (QCD) from your IRA this year. By making the contribution from your Traditional IRA, you are allowed to deduct up to \$100,000 of the QCD from the front of your Form 1040 in arriving at your AGI. This could be even more beneficial, if you are in a Required Minimum Distribution, because this also counts to your Required Minimum Distribution. Please consult with your own personal tax advisor to see if you qualify for this type of contribution and to see how this could be of a tax benefit to you.

Building Use And Decor Committee

The long-awaited AED machine (Automated External Defibrillator) has arrived and has been installed in the Narthex. We plan to have training sessions in January on how to operate the AED and will keep you informed of training dates.

The committee is responsible for the development of policies for the use of the church, and is also responsible for decisions on acceptability of donations of painting, wall hangings, and furniture through the building. The Committee does not meet on a regular basis, but as needed.
