We Worship by Confessing our Sins

- P: We come to this moment of confession in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C: Amen!
- <u>P:</u> Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your loving-kindness; in Your great compassion blot out our offenses. <u>C:</u> Wash us from our wickedness and cleanse us from our sins.
- <u>P:</u> You, O God, know our sin. Nothing is hidden from You. Therefore, You are justified when You speak, and You are right when You judge.
- C: Make us pure, O God. Wash our slate clean. Turn from our sin and remember it no more.
- P: Hide Your face from our sins. Grant us mercy, even though we are unworthy.
- <u>C:</u> Create in us a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within us. Cast us not away from Your presence and take not take Your Holy Spirit from us.
- P: Give us the joy of Your saving help and sustain us with Your bountiful Spirit.
- C: Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your loving-kindness; in Your great compassion blot out our offenses.
- P: Let us take some time to confess our sins before God.

<A moment of silent prayer and reflection>

- P: Almighty God...
- <u>C:</u> We have fallen short of Your glory. We have done things with which You are not well pleased. We have failed to do things that would have helped our neighbor. We confess that sin has come between You and us. O God, We come before You now in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior to ask for Your forgiveness and a cleansing of our hearts. Hear our prayer. We want to be in a right relationship with You. Please remove all those things that we allow to get in the way. We are sorry for what we have done. We humbly come before You with our confessions and thanksgiving. Amen
- <u>P:</u> People of God, you have made confession of your sins before the Lord. Therefore, you are promised forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ. So, by the authority of God our Father and Jesus Christ His only Son and by the power of the Holy Spirit, I boldly and confidently announce the forgiveness of all your sins. You have been washed clean and purified of your sins. Rejoice and be glad, for you are a child of God.
- C: Praise be to God and Amen!

The first reading is from Ruth, the 1st Chapter (ESV)

⁶ Then she arose with her daughters-in-law to return from the country of Moab, for she had heard in the fields of Moab that the LORD had visited his people and given them food. ⁷ So she set out from the place where she was with her two daughters-in-law, and they went on the way to return to the land of Judah. ⁸ But Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, "Go, return each of you to her mother's house. May the LORD deal kindly with you, as you have dealt with the dead and with me. ⁹ The LORD grant that you may find rest, each of you in the house of her husband!" Then she kissed them, and they lifted up their voices and wept. ¹⁰ And they said to her, "No, we will return with you to

your people." ¹¹ But Naomi said, "Turn back, my daughters; why will you go with me? Have I yet sons in my womb that they may become your husbands? ¹² Turn back, my daughters; go your way, for I am too old to have a husband. If I should say I have hope, even if I should have a husband this night and should bear sons, ¹³ would you therefore wait till they were grown? Would you therefore refrain from marrying? No, my daughters, for it is exceedingly bitter to me for your sake that the hand of the LORD has gone out against me." ¹⁴ Then they lifted up their voices and wept again. And Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth clung to her.

¹⁵ And she said, "See, your sister-in-law has gone back to her people and to her gods; return after your sister-in-law." ¹⁶ But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to leave you or to return from following you. For where you go I will go, and where you lodge I will lodge. Your people shall be my

people, and your God my God. ¹⁷ Where you die I will die, and there will I be buried. May the LORD do so to me and more also if anything but death parts me from you."

This reading is from Psalm 1 (ESV) (to be read responsively)

Reader: ¹ Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers;

Congregation: ² but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.

- R: ³ He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither.

 In all that he does, he prospers.
 - <u>C</u>: ⁴ The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.
 - <u>R</u>: ⁵ Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;
 - <u>C</u>: ⁶ for the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
