- P: We come to this moment of confession in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C: Amen!
- P: Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your loving-kindness; in Your great compassion blot out our offenses. C: Wash us from our wickedness and cleanse us from our sins.
- P: You, O God, know our sin. Nothing is hidden from You. Therefore, You are justified when You speak, and You are right when You judge. C: Make us pure, O God. Wash our slate clean. Turn from our sin and remember it no more.
- P: Hide Your face from our sins. Grant us mercy, even though we are unworthy. C: Create in us a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within us. Cast us not away from Your presence and please do not take Your Holy Spirit away from us.

- P: People of God, you have made confession of your sins before the Lord. Therefore, you are promised forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ. So, by the authority of God our Father and Jesus Christ His only Son and by the power of the Holy Spirit, I boldly and confidently announce the forgiveness of all your sins. You have been washed clean and purified of your sins. Rejoice and be glad, for you are a child of God. C: Praise be to God and Amen!

We Hear and Read God's Word

This Reading is from the Book of Isaiah, the 65th Chapter (ESV)

I was ready to be sought by those who did not ask for me; I was ready to be found by those who did not seek me. I said, "Here I am, here I am," to a nation that was not called by my name. I spread out my hands all the day to a rebellious people who walk in a way that is not good, following their own devices; A people who provoke me to my face continually, sacrificing in gardens and making offerings on bricks; Who sit in tombs, and spend the night in secret places; who eat pig's flesh, and broth of tainted meat is in their vessels; Who say, "Keep to yourself, do not come near me, for I am too holy for you." These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire that burns all the day. Behold, it is written before me: "I will not keep silent, but I will repay; I will

indeed repay into their lap ⁷ Both your iniquities and your fathers' iniquities together, says the LORD; because they made offerings on the mountains and insulted me on the hills, I will measure into their lap payment for their former deeds." ⁸ Thus says the LORD: "As the new wine is found in the cluster, and they say, 'Do not destroy it, for there is a blessing in it,' so I will do for my servants' sake, and not destroy them all. ⁹ I will bring forth offspring from Jacob, and from Judah possessors of my mountains; my chosen shall possess it, and my servants shall dwell there.

This Reading is from the Book of Psalms, Psalm 22 (ESV)

Reader:_19 But you, O LORD, do not be far off! O you my help, come quickly to my aid! Congregation:_20 Deliver my soul from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dog!

R: ²¹ Save me from the mouth of the lion! You have rescued me from the horns of the wild oxen! C: ²² I will tell of your name to my brothers; in the midst of the congregation, I will praise you:

R: ²³ You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you offspring of Jacob, glorify him, and stand in awe of him, all you offspring of Israel!

<u>C:</u> ²⁴ For he has not despised or abhorred the affliction of the afflicted, and he has not hidden his face from him, but has heard, when he cried to him.

R: ²⁵ From you comes my praise in the great congregation; my vows I will perform before those who fear him.

C: ²⁶ The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek him shall praise the LORD!

May your hearts live forever!

R: 27 All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you.

C: 28 For kingship belongs to the LORD, and he rules over the nations.

*The Holy Gospel According to St. Luke, the 8th Chapter (ESV)

²⁶ Then they sailed to the country of the Gerasenes, which is opposite Galilee. 27 When Jesus had stepped out on land, there met him a man from the city who had demons. For a long time, he had worn no clothes, and he had not lived in a house but among the tombs. ²⁸ When he saw Jesus, he cried out and fell down before him and said with a loud voice, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg you, do not torment me." ²⁹ For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. (For many a time it had seized him. He was kept under guard and bound with chains and shackles, but he would break the bonds and be driven by the demon into the desert.) 30 Jesus then asked him, "What is your name?" And he said, "Legion," for many demons had entered him. 31 And they begged him not to command them to depart into the abyss. 32 Now a large herd of pigs was feeding there on the hillside, and they begged him to let them enter these. So, he gave them permission. ³³ Then the demons came out of the man and entered the pigs, and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the lake and drowned.

³⁴ When the herdsmen saw what had happened, they fled and told it in the city and in the country. ³⁵ Then people went out to see what had happened, and they came to Jesus and found the man from whom the demons had gone, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind, and they were afraid. ³⁶ And those who had seen it told them how the demon-possessed man had been healed. ³⁷ Then all the people of the surrounding country of the Gerasenes asked him to depart from them, for they were seized with great fear. So, he got into the boat and returned. ³⁸ The man from whom the demons had gone begged that he might be with him, but Jesus sent him away, saying, ³⁹ "Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you." And he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city how much Jesus had done for him.
