The "Adult and Teen Challenge" program, with a campus located in Graham, is a residential, long term recovery and discipleship program for women 18 years and older, suffering from drug and alcohol addiction, and has a capacity for 28 students. Students at the campus take part in vocational training, counseling and therapy, life skills training, education and job training and spiritual growth and discipleship. Adult and Teen Challenge has an 80% success rate.

The Women's Ministry Board recently met with a representative from the local Adult and Teen Challenge organization as to what we could do to assist with their program.
