We Worship by Confessing Our Sins

Pastor: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Congregation: Amen.

- <u>P</u>: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- C: Amen.
- P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- P: (Facing altar which symbolizes God's presence): Most merciful God,
- <u>C:</u> We confess that we are in bondage to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole hearts; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen
- P: (Facing the congregation, declares God's grace): In the mercy of almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for you, and for his sake God forgives you all your sins. To those who believe in Jesus Christ he gives the power to become the children of God and bestows on them the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen. All: Praise the LORD!

We Hear and Read God's Word

The first reading is from Lamentations, the 3rd Chapter (ESV)

- ²² The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end;
- ²³ they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
- ²⁴ "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him."
- ²⁵ The LORD is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him.
- ²⁶ It is good that one should wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD.
- ²⁷ It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.
- ²⁸ Let him sit alone in silence when it is laid on him;
- ²⁹ let him put his mouth in the dust—there may yet be hope;
- ³⁰ let him give his cheek to the one who strikes, and let him be filled with insults.
- ³¹ For the Lord will not cast off forever.
- ³² but, though he cause grief, he will have compassion according to the abundance of his steadfast love;
- ³³ for he does not afflict from his heart or grieve the children of men.

Congregation ²O LORD my God, I cried to you for help, and you have healed me.

- R: ³ O LORD, you have brought up my soul from Sheol; you restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.
- C 4 Sing praises to the LORD, O you his saints, and give thanks to his holy name.
- <u>R:</u> ⁵ For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.
- C 6 As for me, I said in my prosperity, "I shall never be moved."
- R: ⁷ By your favor, O LORD, you made my mountain stand strong; you hid your face; I was dismayed.

- ¹⁰ In that day the root of Jesse, who shall stand as a signal for the peoples—of him shall the nations inquire, and his resting place shall be glorious.
