## BENEVOLENCE FUND RECIPIENT SHOWCASE

A tithe (10%) of giving to Living Word Lutheran Church is re-given to charitable organizations as determined by the Benevolence Committee. The information below are two of the 23 recipients.

**THE FAMILY RENEWAL CENTER** - This agency is a Christian humanitarian organization dedicated to bringing healing, hope, and a new life to victims of domestic violence. Founded in 1986, the center provides confidential services for families experiencing domestic violence, abuse, and elder abuse. They are located at 123 E. 96<sup>th</sup> Street, in Tacoma. They offer a 24 hour crisis line, shelter for adults and children, counseling and therapy, education and support groups, and advocacy and resources for prevention in and around the community, regardless of gender, age, or background. The Center and the hotline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

**WASHINGTON SOLDIERS HOME** - is a 97-unit senior housing facility located in Orting. Established in 1891, it was the first of four homes built for Washington state veterans. To be eligible for admission they must require nursing home level care, including having served in the United States Armed Forces or being a Gold Star Parent who lost a child while serving in the Armed Forces. They offer a range of services, including nursing care, assistance with daily living activities, and social programs.
