When we think about the **Tacoma Rescue Mission**, serving meals and providing a place for people to sleep is the image that usually comes to mind. But the activities of the Mission are much broader than that.

The mission of the Tacoma Rescue Mission is *"to offer God's help, hope and healing to the most impoverished members of our community."* They engage in a variety of services that help them achieve that mission. Their purpose states:



"We help all people; including clients, volunteers, donors and staff, to become uconstructions 5:7 their best. We provide emergency services such as shelter and food to the homeless or hurting; offer self-sufficiency programs to help lift a person from poverty and break the chains of addiction; support prevention programs and share our Christian faith."
