
The high-profile defamation trial in the news these days has brought the issue of domestic violence to the forefront. What is unusual about the Johnny Depp and Amber Heard case is the public manner in which the accusations are being handled. Most victims suffer in silence, and oftentimes, the results are tragic. The Family Resource Shelter in Tacoma responds to the needs of people in such situations, and is one of the recipients of the benevolence funds from Living Word in 2021. The mission of this Christian humanitarian organization is "to bring healing hope and new life to victims of domestic violence." Some of the services the agency provides include:



A national 24-hour domestic violence crisis line; case management; legal referrals; help with housing, educational, and employment searches; relocation and change of identity; emergency advocacy; transportation from hospitals, police stations, churches, motels, and neighbors; transportation for residents' scheduled medical, legal, and personal appointments; on-site animal kennel; pet therapy; cars in good condition for residents without transportation; and, on-site auto repair shop.
