Mobility Equipment Closet Volunteer

Volunteers who tend the mobility equipment lending closet help to store items, issue the items to clients, receive returned items and maintain equipment.

Requirements

A Mobility Equipment Closet Volunteer should have:

- Ability to evaluate that equipment is serviceable,
- Pleasant and helpful manner, and
- Ability to maintain client confidentiality.

Specific Duties

Mobility Equipment Closet Volunteers do the following:

- Call clients who are asking to borrow or return equipment to determine specific needs.
- Arrange to deliver or pick up equipment or meet the client at the Storage Closet and record information about the equipment loan/return.
- Keep the closet organized and secure.
- Provide equipment repair when able, let the coordinator know about equipment maintenance and availability needs.

A more detailed job description is available and a FISH volunteer coordinator will meet with the volunteer for an orientation before working on the first special needs request.
