

Mission Statement:

The mission of the BAGKC, as defined in BAGKC Constitution, Article 1, Section 2 is:

The mission of the Bangladesh Association for Greater Kansas City (BAGKC) is to promote and preserve the Bangladeshi culture and heritage in the Greater Kansas City area.

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Goals:

- Serve as a conduit of knowledge to make people of Bangladeshi heritage aware and be part of mainstream America.
- Serve the interest of the people of Bangladeshi heritage.
- Promote and preserve genuine history and cultural heritage of people of Bangladeshi heritage.
- Facilitate understanding and cooperation among different groups as well as other segments of people of Bangladeshi heritage.
- Organize educational programs to uphold fairness and eliminate all bigotry and hatred within Bangladeshi Americans.

These goals are carried out through programs such as cultural events, publications, seminars and meetings. The Association makes available information on meetings and publications to a wide audience.

The national headquarters of BAGKC is located at Overland Park, Kansas. BAGKC is a registered non-profit entity in the state of Kansas.
