

# Iowa Limousin Association



The Iowa Limousin Association Hall of Fame is designed to honor Iowa Limousin Association (ILA) members, both past and present, which have made a significant contribution towards the advancement of Limousin cattle in the state of Iowa and surrounding region.

1. Recipients are to be nominated by any current ILA member, and final selection will be made by the ILA Board of Directors.
2. Selection will be made by secret ballot. A 75% majority vote of the ILA board of director's is needed for induction.
3. A maximum of 3 recipients may be inducted the first year, with no more than 1 recipient per year thereafter.
4. No more than 1 **active** ILA member may be inducted annually.
5. There will be no obligation for a selection of a recipient in any one year.
6. Recipients may be selected posthumously.
7. Candidates that are not selected may have their names resubmitted in a following year.
8. ILA members wanting to submit a candidate for consideration must submit an application following the requirements listed below and return it to William Long, ILA Secretary. Applications may be submitted at any time with the final selection timeline to be determined by the board's discretion.

## **Application requirements:**

- A. Name of Candidate
- B. What contributions have they made to the Iowa Limousin Association?
- C. How many years have/were they involved in the Iowa Limousin Association?
- D. What contributions have/did they make to the beef industry as a whole?
- E. List any community and civic contributions.
- F. List any cattle industry accomplishments.
- G. All Applications must be signed by 5 active ILA members.
