Bylaws Duties:

Monitor Duties:

Council to the Master of Kadosh. Pronounces discourses when instructed to do so by competent authority.

Installation Duties:

Minister of State: You, as well as the Chancellor, are the Privy Councillor of the Master of Kadosh. Upon all important questions based in the Consistory, it is your special duty to state your conclusions, before the matter is put to vote. It is your province to pronounce such discourses, to visitors of distinction, to Brethren newly received, to the Consistory on solemn occasions, and in honor of the dead, as may be required by the customs of the Order or directed by the competent authority. You should therefore study the Constitutions and Regulations, become familiar with the history of the Order, and thoroughly understand its philosophy. Not satisfied with knowing all that has been rediscovered as to the meaning of the symbols of Masonry, you should, by study and reflection, endeavor to make new discoveries and bring to light the hidden meanings.

Fraternal Duties:

Contact the appointed officers of the Consistory on a regular basis to ensure their attendance at stated meetings, Reunions and other fraternal events.
