

Webb Telescope Discoveries Reconcile Genesis with Science, According to Space Telescope Researcher and Author



ORLANDO, October 3, 2023, This stunning image captured by Webb in the Carina Nebula confirms Hubble's previous findings about [planet-forming disks](#) (NASA) that corresponds exactly to Earth's formation as described in Genesis. Moses left out the fine details of how earth formed, but now these space telescopes are giving us spectacular insights into his simple ancient writings according to space discoveries researcher and author Paul Hutchins.

NASA's Hubble and Spitzer Telescopes discovered locations in our Milky Way Galaxy in 2004, where infant stars are born and mature. Enveloped around these young stars were proto-planetary dust clouds like the ones seen in the Carina Nebula, which scientists say are the materials from which planets are made. Scientists have observed that young stars have huge reservoirs of planet-building materials while more mature stars have less dust around them, as the dust coalesces over time to create planets.

One debris disc imaged by Hubble surrounds a young Sun-like star called [HD 107146](#) (NASA). What was observed fits Genesis' simple description of the Earth's creation as recorded in 1513 BCE. The account of day-1 at Genesis 1:2 states, "Now the earth proved to be formless and desolate, and there was darkness upon the surface." "During its early formation phase the earth was nothing more than a large sterile ball of celestial debris made of rock, metals, and minerals that correspond with Genesis simple description," according to Hutchins.

NASA's scientists have discovered that as planets mature inside their chaotic dusty cocoon they [suck up all the dust](#) (NASA) between them and the sun so that the planets gradually emerge from darkness. The account at Genesis 1:3. States, "Let there be light," "Before this phase the clouds of dust would have been too dense for any light to penetrate to earth's surface."

The years of Research Hutchins did on the Hubble and Spitzer findings lead him to write the book, "[Hubble Reveals Creation](#)" that details how NASA's discoveries correspond to and reconcile with Genesis.

Hutchins says," When reading Genesis in its original Hebrew language, and taking into consideration known science, it's clear that the six creative days are not literal 24-hour days but rather six unspecified periods of development that the earth underwent over perhaps millions of years. It also reveals that the already existing Sun, Moon, and Stars were hidden (from Earth's perspective) by all the dust and not *created* ("bara") after the earth as some believe but were *made* ("asah") visible when the sun fully ignited and gave off a [blast of solar wind](#) (Stephen Hawking) that blew away all the remaining dust. This process he says, corresponds to day-four in Genesis, further showing a connection between the Bible's account and NASA's observations.

He believes that NASA's discoveries reconcile Genesis with known science and that those who hold to the belief that the Earth was created in 6-literal days and that the sun was created after the earth have misinterpreted what Moses recorded and are either ignoring or unaware of the up-to-date scientific facts on planet forming disks as revealed by the Hubble, Spitzer, and now James Webb Space Telescopes.

Without a space telescope according to Hutchins, it could only be through Divine insight that Moses could have wrote that the early earth was formless, desolate, and shrouded in darkness exactly as these 3-Space telescopes have just now discovered.
