



THE WATERS PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

We are delighted that you are considering The Waters as the location for your photos and/or videos. The Waters requires a permit for photography and/or video shoots. In order to obtain a permit, photographers must submit a completed application to The Waters Assembly, 2239 Marler Road, Pike Road, AL 36064 at least **one week** prior to their arrival. Permits cannot be applied for on the intended date of photography. To obtain an application, contact The Waters Assembly Information Center at (334) 277.5551, go to www.TheWatersAssembly.com or email Info@TheWatersAssembly.com. The Waters community is PRIVATE PROPERTY and access is only available through the permitting process. To apply for a permit, please contact us during office hours, Monday-Friday from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm.

The Waters Photography Permit Options	Cost	
A One Year Photography Permit	\$250	The photographer will be issued a digital permit to be kept accessible on the photographer's phone. The permit needs to be printed by the photographer and kept visible from the photographer's car during each photo shoot. The permit is valid for one year from the purchase date.
One Day Photography Permit	\$50	The photographer will be issued a digital permit to be kept accessible on the photographer's phone. The permit needs to be printed by the photographer and kept visible from the photographer's car during the photo shoot. This permit is only valid on the date selected during purchase.

**A permit will not be issued until payment is made.

To ensure a positive experience for you while maintaining a pleasant experience for our homeowners, please be aware of the following rules and guidelines.

- All photography shoots, professional or amateur, require a photography permit.
- A photography business is required to have one permit in the business name. The business must provide a list of employees who will be using the photography permit.
- All photography shoots require that the photographer(s) clearly display their permit while in the neighborhood.
- Access is limited to the date/hours approved based upon submitted permit application.
- Photography must be conducted without disruption to neighborhood operations or limitation to the accessibility of amenities (unless approved on permit) or entrances/exits to neighborhood or homes. You may not interfere with the enjoyment of The Waters by our residents. If you want exclusive rights to a particular place at a particular time at The Waters, you must work out the details with The Waters Assembly ahead of time.
- The traffic flow on drives and pathways cannot be blocked at any time.
- Guests and photographers are not permitted to walk in plant beds or to move, rearrange, or handle any plants or planted containers in any way. Please do not enter flowerbeds, plant displays or mulched areas. Remain on the pathways and grassy turf at all times.
- The Waters reserves the right to ask you to refrain from using any particular picture in the public domain if we find it objectionable in some manner.
- Photography involving nudity is not permitted.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are allowed.
- Pets must be on a leash. You must clean up after any pets brought onto The Waters property.
- Parking on the grass can result in costly damage to our sprinkler systems and is strictly prohibited.



- You may be held liable for any damage to the landscaping or the sprinkler systems.

The Waters Assembly reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to withhold and/or withdraw permission to photograph on its premises. Assembly Members (residents of The Waters), The Waters staff and the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department have authority to approach anyone suspected of conducting an unauthorized photography shoot and to enforce these rules. Failure to comply may result in removal from the premises.

MEDIA PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

All members of the media must make arrangements with The Waters Assembly Management prior to their arrival.
