



## Settling In at Levant International School

Our settling-in approach is designed to be **gentle, responsive, and deeply respectful of each child's emotional needs**, ensuring they feel safe, secure, and at home from the very beginning.

This is not a rigid process. Every child moves at their own pace, and we work closely with parents to support a smooth and positive transition.

### **Our Approach**

We focus on three key foundations:

- **Emotional security before independence**
- **Trust before routine**
- **Connection before expectation**

Our goal is simple:

**for your child to feel safe enough to begin exploring the world around them.**

### **Initial Settling-In (First Few Days)**

We begin with a gentle transition:

- **Day 1:** Parent stays with the child (1–2 hours)
- **Day 2:** Short session (2–3 hours), parent nearby if needed
- **Day 3:** Child begins short independent stay

This flexible structure allows us to build **confidence, familiarity, and trust** at the child's pace.
