Board Members

The *Symphony of the Canyons* Board of Directors/Trustees focus is to ensure the symphony achieves its mission, values, and vision, and manage the financial and legal obligations of a non-profit organization. It oversees operations and approves fundraising and financial expenditures throughout the year.

The Board consists of three to nine members, including, but not limited to, the following officer roles. More than one role may be filled by one person:

<u>President</u>: Sets the tone for the board; runs board meetings; assigns, assists, and ensures completion of tasks; acts as the face of the symphony; and advocates for and promotes its value.

Secretary: Keeps minutes of meetings and records of symphony assets and contact information.

<u>Treasurer</u>: Maintains the symphony's financial records and fulfills the financial and legal obligations of a non-profit orchestra.

<u>Chief Operations Officer</u>: Acts as the primary director of operations, working closely with the Conductor and Board President and overseeing other directors and support staff.

<u>Donations Coordinator</u>: Concentrates on fundraising efforts, such as grant applications, fundraising events, and the recruitment of business and private donations.

No prior experience is needed. Training will be provided.
