The Advent season has begun! This season begins four Sundays before Christmas (this year on November 27) and ends on Christmas Eve. The word "advent" comes from the Latin word adventus meaning "coming" or "visit." In our culture, we often name this as the Christmas season (even though Christmas is a 12 day event that begins on Christmas day). Often, this is a time where we decorate our homes, hang lights, turn on festive music, and buy more than we can often afford. Advent, however, offers us a different focus. "During Advent, we prepare for and anticipate the coming of Christ. We remember the longing of Jews for a Messiah and our own longing for and need of forgiveness, salvation and a new beginning. Even as we look back and celebrate the birth of Jesus in a humble stable in Bethlehem, we also look forward anticipating the second coming of Christ as the fulfillment of all that was promised by his first coming" (resourceumc.org). This is a season of preparation, not of our homes, but of our hearts. How will you make room for Jesus during Advent? How will you prepare for the coming of the savior? I pray you will find time away from the business of the holiday season to grow in faith, to share the Good News, and to serve the world with Christ as your example.


