Please join us in welcoming our new interim pastor, Rev. Jim Barnett. Pastor Jim will serve 1/4 time and preach on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month. **Be sure to join us on Sunday, July 7 as we welcome him to Broadway. There will be a meet and greet with cake and refreshments on July 7 following worship.**

Pastor Jim was called into ministry in 1990 at 40 years of age at which time he began his academic studies in the Course of Study at St. Paul School of Theology in Kansas City, MO. During this time he was appointed to the DeKalb and South Park UMC churches where he served for 2 years. He was then appointed to the Wesley UMC in St. Joseph, MO where he served for 26 years including 2 years serving the King Hill UMC. Pastor Jim retired in 2019 and enjoyed 3 years of retirement before Bishop Bob Farr asked and appointed him to serve as the Interim Lead Pastor at the Savannah UMC where he has been serving for the past 2 years. In June of this year Pastor Jim was appointed as your Interim Pastor here at Broadway UMC and looks forward to sharing Jesus Christ and serving Him in leading folks to become part of God's family here.

Pastor Jim and his wife Julie have been married over 38 years and live just North of Faucett, MO where they purchased a portion of Pastor Jim's family farm. Pastor Jim and Julie have 2 children; Darrin and his wife Tammy Barnett who live in rural Union Star, MO and Andria and Jordon Cunningham who live in rural Faucett, MO. They have been blessed with 9 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren who they cherish and love spending time with. Jim has also spent over 46 years owning and operating Jim Barnett Auction Service in which he and Julie continue to be very active.

In 2022 Pastor Jim was diagnosed with cancer in his neck area. He received 35 radiation and 7 chemo treatments in 7 weeks. During treatment Pastor Jim continued to serve the folks at the Savannah UMC. He is now 2 years cancer-free and says "God gave me healing through His grace, my strong faith along with tremendous Doctors and Staff, I am truly blessed".

Annual Conference:

Annual Conference took place in Saint Charles, MO June 7-9. During the three day conference, both lay and clergy delegates gathered for Holy Conferencing, worship, and attended to the business of the Annual Conference. The conference was full of hope and excitement for the future. During the ordination service, the Bishop invited anyone who was feeling a call to ministry to come forward for prayer. Pastor Cassie said she has never witnessed in her 10+ years of going to conference so many people go forward with their pastors and loved ones to be prayed over. She stated, "you could feel the Spirit move in a remarkable way. The future is bright for the UMC!"

In addition to the regular business, the lay and clergy delegates elected four replacement delegates to attend Jurisdictional Conference. Clergy delegates elected were Rev. Craig Stevenson, a deacon and Rev. Tracey Wolff, an elder. Lay delegates elected were Monique Jones, incoming Conference Lay Leader, and Kyle Boehr. These four will be seated along with the remaining jurisdictional delegation at the South Central Jurisdictional Conference July 10-12 in Rogers, Arkansas. The Annual Conference session also adopted a new parental time off policy, clarifying and adding additional benefits to both clergy and local churches. One change allows local church to receive a grant to pupilit supply while a pastor is off for parental leave.

Methodists on a Mission:

We held our annual local mission trip from June 11 through June 15 at St. Mark's UMC in Independence, MO. Throughout the week we had a total of 19 youth and adults from 4 different churches. During the week we served at four different work sites - Harvesters, Habitat Restore, Fairmount Community Center, and assisting a family with some home cleanup. Each afternoon and evening after the worksite, we enjoyed time swimming, playing games, and worshiping God. Our worship series this year was titled "Emanuel - Struggling to Find God" where we explored topics such as finding God in the dark times of life, recognizing God's plan in our life, and taking the step to say "yes" to receiving God's unconditional love. On the Saturday morning during our closing worship, two youth said "yes" fully to receiving God into their lives and were baptized!

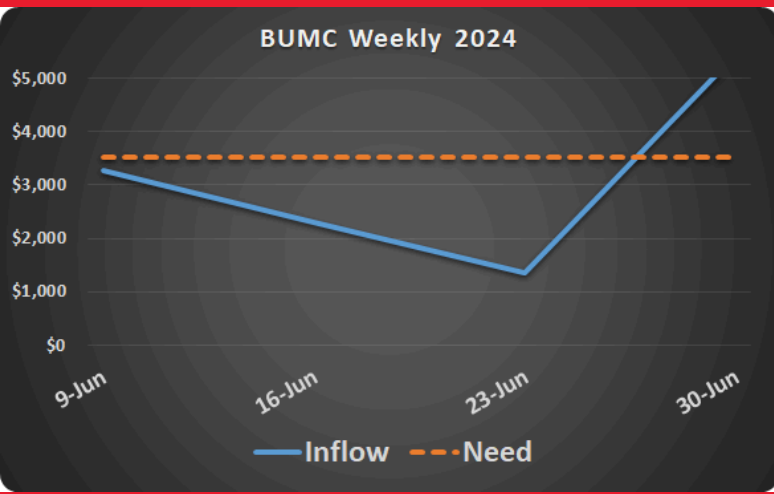

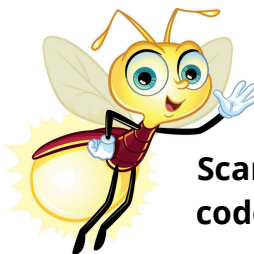
The next mobile pantry is tentatively July 8 at 10am at the fire station due to VBS at FBC. It will no longer be in Lathrop.
