### The Pastor's Pen

The New Year is quickly approaching, not only are we beginning a new year, we are also beginning a new decade. With this season we are granted the opportunity to both reflect on what has passed and anticipate what is to come. Each and everyday, this is the space we live in as Christians: reflecting on what God has done and preparing for what God is going to do next. Seemingly, with each stroke of the new year, I hear people wonder, "will this be the last?" I remember December 31, 1999 sitting in my grandmothers living room, watching old movies. Cars had been lined up at the gas station all day filling their tanks. Some thought, "this is the going to be the end of the world." Others anticipated Christ's return and being elevated into their heavenly homes.\* Either way, people thought something big was going to happen... a new year, a new decade, and a new millennia all in one. And yet, the end of a new year is not about fear, but about hope for a promised future. A new year affords us the opportunity to reset, to reorient. It calls for repentance and for our work at God's children to continue. In the past, I have preached several sermons about our beliefs as United Methodist about the "last things." The fancy theological term for this "eschatology," or the doctrine of the last things; basically what happens in the end. I believe in what scholars call an "inaugurated eschatology," which recognizes the Kingdom of God is already present though the life, death, and resurrection or Jesus and it's not yet hear as we wait for Christ's return. Personally, I think this is much more hope-filled way to think about heaven. We're experiencing the fullness of God here and now while waiting for it to be full realized in the future. As I think about the next year, the new decade, I am hopeful for what 2020 will bring, especially knowing God is already here and working on our very midst. My resolution this year and everyday, is to open my eyes to see God at work and refocus on living out the call God has placed on my life. Will you join me in doing this same?
