



You may have noticed the news cast of the homeless camping around the Westport area, the city leaders have now moved them to multiple motels for up to sixty days where they are able to seek employment which requires them to have an address of residency, but they do not have a means of cooking meals in their rooms so The KC Hero's Project and Catch Up with Jesus Project are trying to provide 1,400 meals per day, which is a tall order to fill. They continue to be in need of men and women clothing, shoes, socks, under garments and personal items.
