The Food Pantry is in need of canned vegetables, especially green beans and corn. They also need canned peaches.

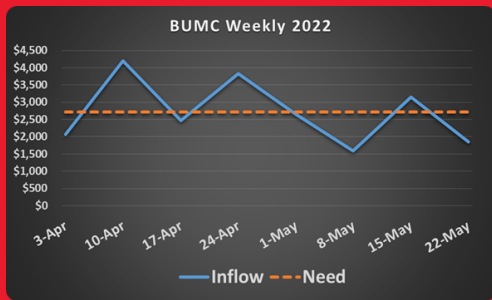

The board met on Monday, May 9 at 7:00 p.m. The following agenda items were discussed:

- Goal Review - plans to launch two adult small groups in the Fall and a quarterly children's ministry following VBS.
- Kitchen demolition will begin on or around June 1.
- Rod McQuerrey spoke about the Boy Scouts. We will no longer be the chartering organization per recommendation from the Missouri Annual Conference.
- Following the youth mission trip planning meeting on June 5, the youth will clean up the portion of C Hwy adopted in memory of Sue Hageman. The whole church is invited.
- Two \$250 scholarships were awarded to Olivia Enderle and Natalie Garr.
- Unanimous approval to sponsor the Care Portal storage unit for two months (total \$130)
- PPR discussed staff salaries and the board held a unanimous vote to increase salaries for two staff members effective May 1. Note: All PPR meetings are closed.
