## Pastor's Pen

Before Jesus ascends into heaven, he entrusted the disciples some pretty clear directions - GO and make new disciples (Matthew 28:19). As United Methodists we believe our mission is to "make disciples of lesus Christ for the transformation of the world." While church attendance isn't the only measurement of discipleship - it is an opportunity for persons to encounter God through community and grow as faithful disciples through sharing their prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. Church matters. Community matters. While there is importance in personal prayer and individual communion with God that same God also created us for and commands us to be part of community. Pastors, church members, and other leaders ask - well, how do we make disciples? How do we get others to come to church? The answer is an invitation. That's what Jesus did. They conducted a national survey and 82% of the non-churched say they would come to church with a friend or relative if invited" (ibid.). We all know someone without a faith community. On Sunday, September 17, we are hosting "Bring a Friend Sunday," followed by a luncheon after worship. I pray each of you will invite a friend (or two or three) to join us for worship. If you haven't been to church in a while, this is also a great opportunity for you to reengage with your church family. Please know, you are always welcome! #### **Vacation Bible School**





#### **Food Pantry News:**

For the month of July, the food pantry served 41 families, 110 individuals, and 2 new families (5 individuals). 294 volunteer hours were logged and 888 pounds of food was donated.

The food pantry always needs the following items: laundry soap, cereal (hot and cold), canned fruits and veggies, pork and beans, soup, toilet paper, pancake mix, peanut butter, evaporated milk, crackers, tuna, tooth paste, bar soap, vinegar, and mac & cheese Please be sure any food items are not expired.

#### **Board Meeting Summary:**

The board met on Monday, August 14, via Zoom. The following items were discussed:

- Goals and financial report discussed. We are planning to write two grants to 1) help with launching a grief group and 2) cultivate generosity through potential capital campaign.
- Kyle gave reports about summer mission week, VBS, and Youth Group plans for fall.
- September ministries and worship events discussed.
- The trustees approved \$8,600 to replace HVAC, gutter and window replacement at the parsonage (\$12,467), and rehabbing the downstairs church bathrooms (<\$1). The parsonage deck and shower doors in the master bath are also being fixed. Many of the expenses will be paid for using trustee's funds. Trustees also discussed potential steps in restoring stained glass windows in the sanctuary and reviewed bid from 6/22.
- PPR discussed staff paid leave and time-off requests. Contact Pastor Cassie or Ken Tongue to receive a copy of the agenda, minutes, and/or reports. All board meetings are open to the congregation. The next board meeting is on September 11, 2023.
