




Youth Christmas Party:

In the month of November, the food pantry served 50 families, totaling 147 individuals. Four of those families were new to the Plattsburg food pantry. Those families were Abby Daffron - 09 comprised of eight new individuals. 322 volunteer hours were logged. 2,265 pounds of food was donated. 21 Plattsburg school families were served Thanksgiving care packages. Christmas dinners were given out on December 21st, more info on families served for Christmas will be coming next month.
