
Good Grief:




GOOD GRIEF

Plattsburg Food Pantry:

In July, the food pantry served 139 individuals which were made up of 50 different households in the community. The pantry served four new individuals (one household). 119 hours of volunteer time was logged and 677.45 pounds of food was donated. As a reminder, the food pantry is open Thursdays from 8:30-11:00am. **The Second Harvest Mobile Pantry is now located at the Plattsburg Fire Station @ 10:00am on the second Monday of the month.**

August Board Meeting Minutes:

- The board motioned to move \$5000 from the designated trustees fund into the general fund
- The grief group budget was motioned and approved (funds still provided by grant)
- Childcare will need to be provided for Good Grief beginning September 16, reach out to the office if you can help
- The church received new chairs from Peculiar UMC and will try to sell old chairs via Facebook Marketplace
- The board is setting a date for a fire and safety inspection in order to form appropriate procedures, provide training when necessary, and post the information for all who use the church building
- Fall Festival community worship will take place Oct. 13th
- Dinner on Broadway continues to be a successful ministry, serving 88 meals in August
