


To grow in the faith of Christ by reaching out and connecting with others through intentional service and witness.


Leader Spotlight:

In February, the food pantry served 30 families, including 87 individuals and 1 new family. 488.7 pounds of food was donated, including 15 pounds that was returned from TEFAP and donated. 105 volunteer hours were logged.

March Board Meeting:

- Youth and Children's ministry is getting into busy season with planning an End of Year youth party, Methodists on a Mission (June 23rd-28th), and VBS.
- New carpet was installed at the parsonage on March 20th.
- For Easter services this year we will be hosting a Living Last Supper meal on 4/17, as well as an Easter breakfast @ 9:00am, Easter egg hunt at 9:30am and Easter worship @ 10:40am on 4/20. No Good Friday service this year.
