May we also ask God to soften hearts toward peace in every place on earth.

Peace begins with each of us. Nearly 900 years ago, St. Francis of Assisi wrote a prayer that still speaks:

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace:
where there is hatred, let me sow love;
where there is injury, pardon;
where there is doubt, faith;
where there is despair, hope;
where there is darkness, light;
where there is sadness, joy.
O Divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek
to be consoled as to console,
to be understood as to understand,
to be loved as to love.
For it is in giving that we receive,
it is in pardoning that we are pardoned,
and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

Let's put this prayer into practice—by reaching out with love and grace in our daily lives, here at home and beyond.


